ProMetic Plasma Resources Inc. is a plasma collection center based in Winnipeg, Manitoba, Canada. This center provides ProMetic with readily accessible specialty plasma necessary to bring to market innovative plasma derived therapeutic solutions.

ProMetic Plasma Resources Inc. is looking for a RN – Physician Substitute, to work at its collection center in Winnipeg, Manitoba. Under supervision of the Plasma Center Manager, the RN – Physician Substitute will be responsible for those duties necessary to determine donor suitability, supervision of adverse reactions, counseling of unacceptable donors and ensuring that safe and acceptable medical/laboratory practices are observed at all facilities. This is a full time, permanent position.

The mandate of the RN – Physician Substitute will consist mainly of:

- Performing medical histories and physical examinations of normal healthy donors and non-infectious disease state donors when such donors meet the criteria for normal plasma donors.
- Providing a thorough and clear explanation of all relevant informed consents and AIDS educational material, which includes high-risk behavior information.
- Giving the donors the opportunity to self-exclude in a private setting.
- Evaluating and following up on donor reactions and initiating emergency medical procedures as needed.
- Referring unstable donors to medical facilities as necessary via appropriate medical supervision, such as ambulance or paramedical services.
- Performing periodic reviews of laboratory data and collections records to determine the donor's continued safety and suitability.
- Providing counseling for donors with unsuitable test results.
- Administering RBC immunizations under the direct supervision of the licensed physician.
- Supervising and/or administering vaccines to donors participating in immunization programs other than RBC immunizations.

- Acting as liaison between the plasma center and the medical community.
- Notifying the center physician as soon as possible of any moderate and/or severe donor reaction. Follow-up on minor reactions.
- Other related duties/responsibilities as required or assigned by the supervisor.

The selected candidate will be qualified as a Nurse Practitioner (NP), Physician Assistant (PA), Registered Nurse (BSN or RN), Licensed Practical or Vocational Nurse (LPN or LVN), Paramedic or Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) and hold a current Manitoba license or certificate.

The following criteria are also required:

- Current certification in Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR);
- Customer Service and Phlebotomy experience with excellent proficiency in blood draws.
- Demonstrated exceptional customer service skills and Ability to create a positive donor experience.
- Understanding of health care and business demonstrated in an ability to promote ProMetic services and build client/donor relationships.
- Demonstrated ability to work as part of a team valuing respectful relationships.
- Conscientiousness.
