Firefighter Paramedics and Primary Care Paramedics will be given hiring priority.

The Firefighter Paramedic or Firefighter is a diversely skilled and a key component of an integrated fire and emergency medical response system.

As the **Firefighter Paramedic or Firefighter** you will be responsible for:

- Responding to emergent and non-emergent calls for service and providing firefighting response, rescue services and emergency medical care.
- Participating in public education, injury prevention, and community relations activities.
- Carrying out vehicle, equipment and station maintenance duties.
- Dependent on level of training and skill, incumbents may participate in specialty programs such as: Hazardous Materials, Technical Rescue, Vehicle Rescue, Water Rescue, etc.

The Primary Care Paramedic is central to high quality emergency medical response, pre-hospital and community based medical care. The Winnipeg Fire Paramedic Service employs both Primary Care and Advance Care Paramedics. Advanced Care Paramedics have a higher scope of practice and provide advanced life support.

As the **Primary Care Paramedic** you will be responsible for:

- Responding to emergent and non-emergent situations and providing emergency medical care and transport to hospital.
- Participating in public education, injury prevention, and community relations activities.
- Carrying out vehicle, equipment and station maintenance duties.
- Dependent on level of training and skill, incumbents may participate in specialty programs such as: Tactical Emergency Medical Service Paramedic, Main Street Project Community Paramedic, EPIC, etc.
